ORDER

AND NOW, this 29th day of June, 2016, it is hereby **ORDERED** that pursuant to Section 2811-D (d) (2) of the Act (Act 7 of 2016), each Bureau Director is authorized to discharge the day-to-day licensing, enforcement and administrative operations of the Commission, including, but not limited to making any initial decisions regarding appeals/hearings coming before the Commission; review, approve and coordinate budgetary matters with the Department and exercise all other powers and duties expressly enumerated in Section 2811-D (d) (3) of the Act. Notwithstanding the above, the Commission shall retain the exclusive and final regulatory authority and jurisdiction over the conduct of horse racing and all pari-mutuel wagering activities within the Commonwealth, as further set forth in 2811-D (e). This delegation Order is subject to the Commission's ongoing review and approval and may be modified at any time by the Commission.
