Racetrack Handle & Racetrack Attendance at Harrah's Chester (Philadelphia):

We are entering our 13th live racing season in 2018 and we continue to gain recognition on the national racing scene. This has been evident since the first season in 2006.

On-track Handle & Attendance:

The on-track handle & attendance has remained in-line with industry trends over the first 11 years at Harrah's Philadelphia. We have experimented with a different schedule of days & post times trying to find our right place in the racing market. Our very popular Sunday matinee has been a constant for us as we have been a very popular "family outing" for the Philadelphia market on Sunday afternoons. We have been able to bring back great excitement to the Delaware Valley Racing scene by hosting some great Stakes from the old days of Brandywine & Liberty Bell. These favorites have brought some great crowds out to Harrah's Philadelphia on Sunday afternoons. In 2009 we tried some late afternoon / early evening weekday Post Times (5pm) with the hope that we could increase on-track attendance. We were able to generate some interest with our Friday evenings cards but our other weeknights underperformed in comparison to the previous years daytime racing programs. The overall blend of days ended keeping our on-track handle almost steady from 2008 to 2009. We had our very best season in terms of Handle Growth in 2010. The move back to Day Racing was the key to our success. In addition our racing received increased national attention in 2010. During the 2011 thru 2015 Racing Seasons we worked closely with the PHHA on several targeted promotional days, these days were specific for the race guests and generated interest and Handle. In 2016 the focus continues to be on targeted High Volume days to increase visitation by the casual race fans. Also in 2016 we have enhanced our mkt program thru our partnership with the PHHA, a new outdoor billboard campaign along with a bus mkt program (bus wraps) we are working to increase awareness in the Philadelphia market about Live Racing at Harrah's Philadelphia. In 2017 we have included a series of commemorative night cards to celebrate the history of Delaware Valley Harness Racing. We had a very successful anniversary celebration and hope to continue with some special event themes for our fans. Similar type Events are planned for 2018 with a Strong Emphasis on Family Day Sunday's.

The Handle & Attendance statistics are attached and separated by year 2006 through 2017.

Live Racing Export Handle:

This is where Harrah's Philadelphia has gained tremendous national attention on the racing scene. Currently Harrah's Philadelphia exports its live racing signal to nearly 500 wagering locations in North America. Harrah's Philadelphia showed tremendous growth from 2006 through 2008 as our Export Handle grew significantly each of those years. We hit our "bump in the road" in 2009, the decision to race late afternoon / early evening was not helpful to the export program. Prior to the 2010 racing season our best season for export handle was 2008 when we averaged over 475k daily. The switch to nights impacted our export handle downward by 15% in 2009. The in-state export showed the most significant decreases as five of the six racetracks in the state were all racing at night, this ended up splitting the in-state export handle to all five PA Racetracks. These results led Harrah's Philadelphia to move its 2010 Post Time back to afternoon's at 12:45pm.The 2010 resulted in tremendous growth in Export Handle over 2009. We also showed growth over 2008 when we had gained strong national attention not only in the United States but Canada as well. Racing at Harrah's Philadelphia is simulcast all through the major Racing markets in both countries. The 2011 thru 2015 racing seasons remained steady compared to 2010 in the Export markets. The expectation is that we will continue to remain strong in 2016 despite continued industry declines nationally. The racing schedule in 2016 & 2017 & 2018 is targeted to take advantage of export opportunities.

NATIVE BREEDING & CLASS & RESIDENCE

Native Breeding:

Harrah's Philadelphia has developed a great relationship with the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association (PHHA). Over the years we have worked with the Horsemen to promote racing opportunities for PA Sired & Owned Horses & now PA Stabled Horses. The PHHA offers an incentive / bonus program for PA Owned & Sired Horses. Our current Horsemen's agreement grants final approval of the Weekly Condition sheet to the Horsemen. We continue to evaluate opportunities to promote racing to PA Owned & Sired Horses. We look forward to being able to enhance that program with the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association as we move into the future.

Class:

Harrah's Philadelphia is the host to World Class Racing action. The highlight of some previous seasons has been Super Stakes Sunday. Other Great Stakes include the Betsy Ross & Maxie Lee Stakes and new in 2016 was the Dorothy Mullin Invitational which featured some of the best horses in training. The race was named in honor of Ben Stafford Jr in 2017. Our Daily Overnights average nearly 160k per day as we have one of the highest Purse Structures in North America. Harrah's Philadelphia has also been active participants in the PA Sire Stakes & Stallion Series Programs.

Residence:

In 2009 & 2010, 21% of the Purses Paid went to PA Residents. In 2011, 24% of the Purses Paid went to PA Residents and in 2012 nearly 30% of the Purses Paid went to PA Residents. 2013 saw that # increase to 32% and in 2014 that # has grown to 39%. The total amount paid to in state residents has steadled over the last 4 years coming in at about 1/3 in 2017. Harrah's Philadelphia has participated in conducting New Owner Seminars sponsored by the United States Trotting Association & Harness Racing Communications. The PHHA also has been active in promoting ownership to PA Residents with various programs.
