


Invasive Species Conservation District Survey

Summary of Results

- 7 questions were presented to PA Conservation Districts (66)
- 76% of the CDs responded to the survey




Other than Mosquito-born Disease Control, does your county conservation district currently have an established invasive species program, either to control the species or educate the public about invasive species?






If there would be an opportunity for your district to participate in a local CISMA and focus on a particular invasive species, how would you envision your role?

What is the biggest threat to the natural resources in your county, and how would your conservation district best play a role in facilitating eradication or control of the invasive species?

Common Threats Identified

•	Invasive Terrestrial Plants =	40%
---	-------------------------------	-----

- Invasive Aquatic Plants = 10%
- Invasive Insects = 38%
- Ticks = 2%
- Other (Stormwater, Pollution, Erosion, etc) 10%



Other than Mosquito-born Disease Control, what invasive species are you concentrating on controlling and what funding source does the district utilize for the program?

•	None or N/A =	35%
•	Education/Outreach only =	21%
•	Insect =	20%
•	Aquatic plants =	4%
•	Terrestrial plants =	20%



Funding Sources?

• State (PDA, DCNR, PACD, Growing Greener) = 25%

•	Federal =	2%
•	No Funding =	13%
•	No Response =	60%



What legal structure or framework do you need in order to participate in a CISMA?

•	Unsure or N/A =	38%
•	Contract/MOU/Agreement =	33%
•	Board Approval only =	17%
•	Funding concerns =	8%
•	No Response =	4%
