Invasive Insects of Greatest Concern to Pennsylvania

Threat Category:

- Potential: Not yet found in Pennsylvania, but considered a potential threat.
- Emerging: Has been detected in some locations, with risk of spreading.
- Established: Widely established in Pennsylvania.

Score: A composite score from 0-80 reflecting the potential invasiveness of a species and its economic, environmental, and human health impacts using a modified <u>Generic Impact Scoring System for invasive species</u>. The scoring system was modified to include an assessment of invasive potential. Species without scores have yet to be evaluated.
