The Entomology Program at the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture can provide identification of arthropod specimens of invasive or regulatory nature. Please complete this form to be submitted with the specimen(s). Specimens without this form will not be identified.

SPECIMEN REQUIREMENTS:

REQUIRED INFORMATION:

- 1. All specimens should be dead.
- 2. Most specimens should be placed in 70-80% Ethyl or Isopropyl Alcohol in a leak proof vial. (Moths, Butterflies, and Mealy bugs should be frozen and placed in a hard plastic container with dry paper toweling)
- 3. The vial should be placed in a zipper style bag.
- 4. Specimens from different locations (if applicable) should be placed in different vials.
- 5. A completed sample submission form must accompany the vial/container.
