Hemp Crop Loss Report - Due within ten days of final crop destruction.



- For every hemp lot included in a planting report submitted to the Department which **WILL NOT BE HARVESTED** for some reason (i.e. pest damage, rot, pollination, etc.), the permit holder must submit a Crop Loss Report.
- A photograph of the destruction is helpful but not required.
